Vespers for All Saints

Fr. Ted Wroblicky 1937 – 2019

Fr. Theodore (Ted as he was called) was born in Harvey, Illinois (Southside Chicago). His father immigrated to the United States from Polish-controlled Western Ukraine. Fr. Ted and his wife Barbara moved their four sons and themselves to Sacramento in 1977, where they settled and raised their children. He is a founder of St. Andrew the First-Called parish.

Fr. Ted was ordained a deacon at St. Ignatius Parish at the hand of Bishop Innocent Lotocky, the Ukrainian Catholic Bishop of Chicago, after completing studies taught by the Sacramento Diocese with oversight from the Diaconate Director in Chicago. As a deacon Fr. Ted simultaneously served as the administrator of Immaculate Conception parish in San Francisco, St. Vladimir parish in Santa Clara, and St. Andrew the First-Called. He attended St. Alfonse Seminary in Lviv and was ordained a priest in 1999 at the hand of Bishop Michael Koltun of Zboriv and served as a priest there.

Fr. Ted returned to the United States in 1999 and was appointed the director of development and communications for the St. Nicholas Eparchy in Chicago where he and his wife Barbara established the Eparchy's stewardship and development office and authored a bilingual Parish Stewardship Handbook. Upon the sudden death of the eparchial finance officer, he was asked by then Bishop Michael Wiwchar to serve as the Eparchial Finance Director. He continued under the ordinariate of Bishop Richard S. Seminack until his return to Sacramento in 2006.

He founded Holy Wisdom Parish in Sacramento and was a chaplain emeritus for the Knights of Columbus. He has taught in a number of lecture programs and parish missions. He frequently presented programs on Immaculate Heart Radio (1620 AM) and seeks out opportunities to speak about his passion, Christ and His Eastern Christian people and Churches. Fr. Ted is survived by Barbara, his wife of over 50 years. They have been blessed with four sons, five grandsons, and three granddaughters.

Words from Bishop Benedict

During the Divine Liturgy we hear these words frequently, "Be attentive!" God spoke to His People two thousand years ago and now He doesn't stop speaking to each one of us also.

We should be attentive to God's voice, which we can especially hear during our encounter with Him – at prayer. To listen attentively to those movements of the heart, to those experiences and thoughts which the Lord gives us: to hear God through these or other words which someone speaks to us; to give heed to the events which happen in our life...

...to pay heed to these or other of my feelings. God gave us ears in order that we might give heed to all that is happening around us.

Mostly we are accustomed to think that everything which happens, creates as if to say a background, however when we begin to listen attentively to the events, see the situations, look at the experience then we understand that all of that is as if a great symphony. God is always present in our life and only we are not always ready or capable of hearing Him!
